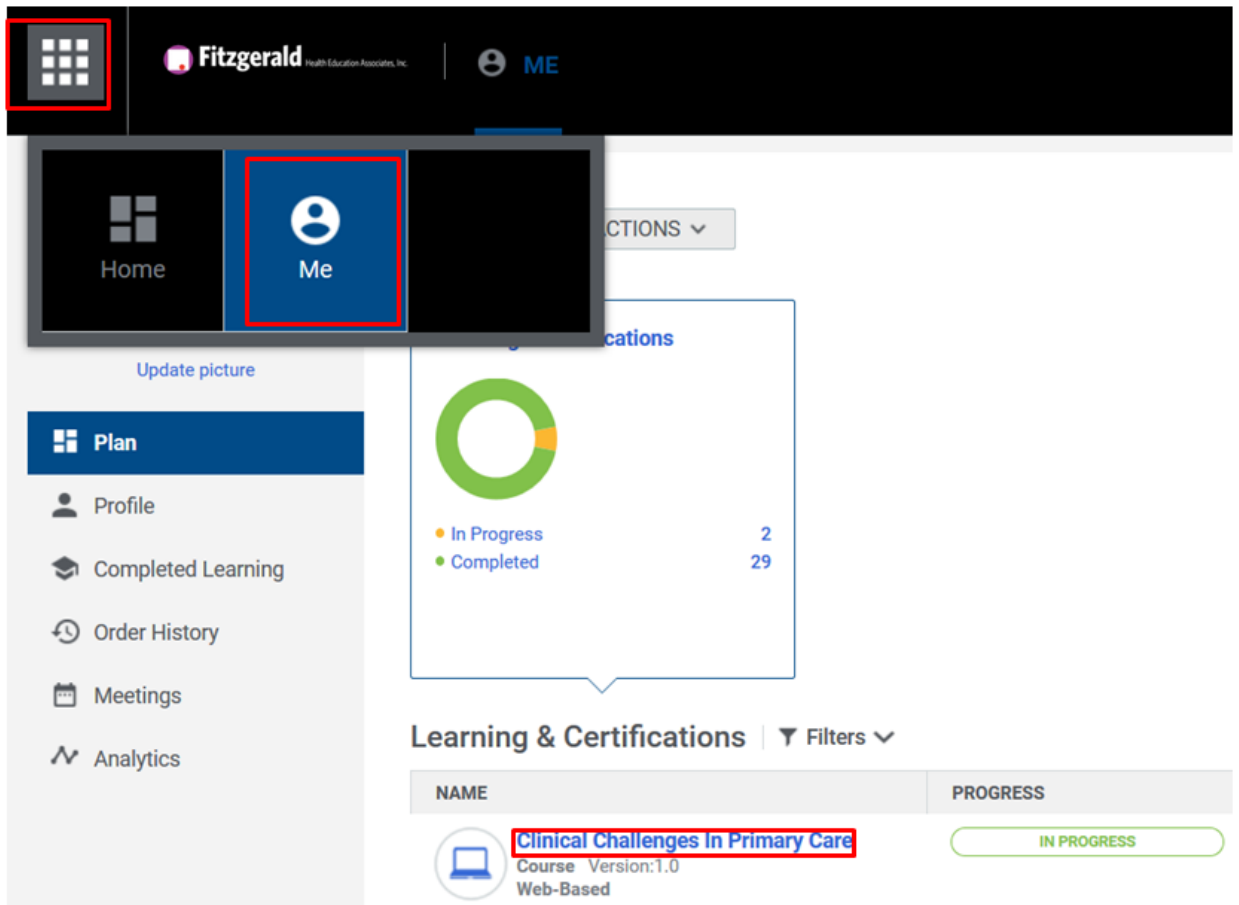

EXIT REVIEW

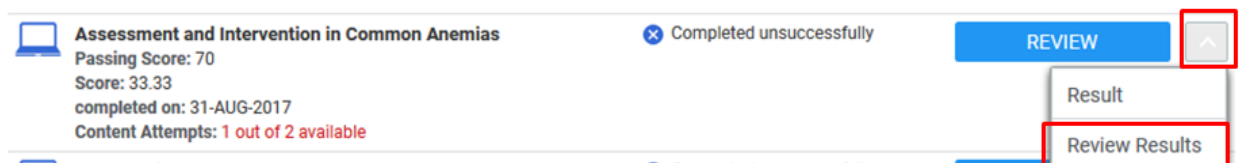
